DAYS 3, 4 & 5:

MASAI MARA NATIONAL RESERVE

Next Morning we fly to Masai Mara where we can get ready for Big 5 encounters.

Maasai Mara, also sometimes spelled Masai Mara and locally known simply as The Mara, is a large National Game Reserve in Kenya, and borders the Serengeti National Park in Tanzania. Masai Mara is one of the most famous and important wildlife conservation and wilderness areas in Africa, world-renowned for its exceptional populations of lion, leopard, cheetah and African bush elephant. It also hosts the Great Migration, which secured it as one of the Seven Natural Wonders of Africa, and as one of the ten Wonders of the World. While here at the Mara we will spend the next 2 nights exploring the Sandriver and the Talek area, two of the richest predator areas of the Mara.





In the afternoon when the heat starts to die down you will set off on your first game drive in search of the predators and a plethora of game viewing and photographic opportunities that are every bit as superb as advertised, expect the unexpected and enjoy every second of anticipation! but fear not...the Mara always delivers.

After a productive search for game, Sundowners shall be enjoyed whenever and wherever the end of the day meets us – a daily chance to enjoy the vast plains of the Masai Mara – a breathtaking and unbeatable way to finish the day! On return to camp there will be hot showers and a scrumptious dinner waiting at the candle lit tent. After dinner, sit around the campfire and enjoy the starry African night and once safely escorted to your tent by your Masai Warrior, you will be lulled asleep to the sound of grazing Hippo and roaring lion.

Extension to trip: Gorilla Trekking in Rwanda





RWANDA: Lying at the heart of Africa, Rwanda is one of the most dynamic leisure destinations, offering vibrant cities, pristine wilderness, and an exceptionally hospitable people. A unique and largely undiscovered venue, Rwanda also offers unrivaled biodiversity, beautiful mountains, some of the oldest and most precious rain forests on earth, five volcanoes, 23 lakes, numerous waterfalls and three stunning national parks.

Regarding wildlife, Rwanda boasts 13 species of primates (25% of the total number in Africa) and 670 species of birds, many of which are globally endangered.

DAY 2:

KIGALI/VOLCANOES NATIONAL PARK

After breakfast you will visit the genocide museum and enjoy a city tour of Kigali. After lunch, depart on scenic drive Northwest wards through the beautiful, terraced hillsides that display

Rwanda's landscape. Arrive at Ruhengeri, the base for gorilla trekking at the Parc National des Volcans. The town itself is located only 25 km from Uganda border, is relatively a small city of about 70,000 people. The constant flow of humanity is quite remarkable. The Town has great views of the surrounding volcanoes. People are very friendly here and although a former Belgian colony (and thus French-speaking), many people speak English here.

DAY 3:

GORILLA TREKKING DAY

When visiting the 'Land of a thousand Hills," one should not miss out on the magnificent opportunity to visit Volcanoes National Park consisting of 125 km2 of mountain forest and home to the six Virunga Volcanoes and the world-famous mountain gorillas.

Protected within the PNV, the lushly forested slopes of the mountains form an appropriately dramatic natural setting for what is arguably the most poignant and memorable wildlife experience in the world: gorilla trekking. The exhilarating climb to the gorilla's natural habitat of shady bamboo forest offers fantastic views in all directions, before the trekkers are immersed in the mysterious intimacy of the rainforest, alive with the calls of colorful birds and the chattering of rare golden monkeys.

Nothing can prepare one for the impact of encountering a fully-grown silverback gorilla, up to three times the size of an average man, yet remarkably peaceful and tolerant of human visitors.





Please remember to bring your passport for registration, appropriate, waterproof hiking boots, and a light raincoat. To protect from stinging nettles, we recommend long pants and long-sleeved tops. A pair of old gardening gloves can help grab onto the vegetation while most hotels/lodges provide a walking stick that comes in very handy especially when hiking downhill. A small waterproof backpack is an excellent idea to carry a light snack, bottled water as well as protection for your camera.

Upon sighting the gorillas, you spend the allowed one hour with them as they go about their daily life; feeding, moving, playing, raising their young and sometimes wrestling by the juveniles – it is a totally unique and unforgettable experience!
